To celebrate the 20th Anniversary of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child, the Scottish Alliance for Children's Rights is hosting a free seminar. The seminar is targeted at all those working with children, with an interest in children's rights and will take participants through the principles of the UNCRC from a basic to more advanced level.

The seminar will:

- Use the 20th Anniversary to celebrate and raise awareness of the UN Convention on the Rights of Child
- Show how the UNCRC can be used to improve the lives of children on a local, regional and national level.
- Highlight how children's organisations can work with SACR to promote and monitor the UNCRC in Scotland.

Who should attend:

This seminar will be of interest to those working with and for children and young people throughout Scotland. It will be of particular interest to practitioners across the voluntary and statutory sectors who want to improve their understanding of children's rights and ensure the UNCRC is integral in their work. This is likely to include those involved in children's services, youth work, teaching, health, education, social work, and community learning and development. It is suitable for those with very little knowledge of the UNCRC through to those with a more advanced understanding.
